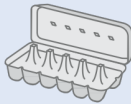
Plastic bottles, jars, and jugs

Paper egg cartons



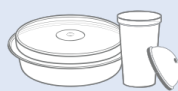
Paper bags

Plastic or paper take-out cups, bowls, and lids



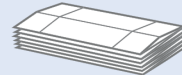
Cartons for milk, soup, etc.



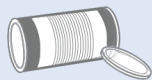
Boxboard boxes and packaging



Shredded paper (contained in paper bag or box)



Corrugated cardboard boxes



Metal cans



Aerosol cans (empty)



Foil wrap and take-out containers



Magazines, catalogues, phone books

Household paper

- Plastic packaging for toys and other household items
- Spiral wound cans and lids for frozen juice concentrate, coffee, etc.
- Plastic tubs for yogurt, margarine, etc.

- Plastic pails less than 25L for laundry detergent, etc.
- Plastic packaging for shampoo, hand soap etc.
- Paper carry-out beverage trays

- Cores from paper towel and toilet tissue
- Paper gift wrap
- Paper gift bags
- Paper bags for flour, sugar, etc.

### NOT ACCEPTED



Hangers, pots, pans, and other scrap metal



Toys and games



Hazardous waste (needles, flammable/ explosive/ toxic material etc.)



Paper towels, napkins and tissues



Hard and soft cover books

Glass bottles (not deposit)

Clear and coloured

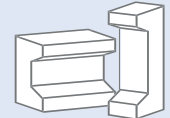
### FOAM PACKAGING - White and Coloured Separate



Foam meat trays  
(remove absorbent pad)



Foam take-out containers and cups



Foam packaging used to protect electronics etc.

### PLASTIC BAGS AND OVERWRAP



Outer bags and plastic overwrap



Plastic bags

- Bags for groceries, produce, bulk dry foods, water softener, wood pellets, etc.
- Overwrap for toilet paper, paper towel, soft drink flats, etc.

### NOT ACCEPTED

- X Drinking glasses, or dishes
- X Window glass, mirrors, or ceramic
- X Light bulbs
- X Blue or pink foam insulation, packing chips, or peanuts
- X Flexible foam, foam noodles
- X Foil lined bags (chip and snack bags)
- X Kitchen stretch wrap or "crinkly" plastic (pasta or cereal bags)

**RINSE OFF ALL FOOD AND RESIDUE BEFORE RECYCLING**
