**Background:**

During the meeting of the Public and Technical Advisory Committee (PTAC) on March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020, representatives from the Regional District's Solid Waste Planning consultant, Morrison Hershfield, will provide a presentation on Options for Residual Waste Management at Existing Facilities to consider for the Solid Waste Management Plan (Attachment #1).
