The Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine (RDKS) is engaged in planning activities to be proactive in minimizing risk, as well as managing and mitigating any potential COVID-19 impacts in our facilities and operations as well as to the services we deliver. Effective immediately the Recreation Centre will facility will be closed to the public until further notice. Pre-scheduled camps will be phased out by the 19th. We believe this will help to meet our obligation to protect the health and well-being of our employees, contractor, the community and the residents and apologize for the inconveniences this will create.

The Facility Operations contractor, Recreation Excellence, is making preparation for this closure including informing groups that may have event bookings.
