

Grants of up to \$30,000 Available to Small Businesses

Small and medium sized businesses that can show a 30% loss in revenue from March 2020 to the time of application compared to the same one-month period the year before, can apply. The application deadline is August 31st, or as soon as funding is exhausted (whichever comes first) so apply early.

Applicants are required to develop a recovery plan in order to access the funds. Don't let this deter you. Remember, an hour or two of work can yield a big investment in your business.

CEBA deadline has been extended

June 30, 2021 is the current deadline for applications to the \$60,000 CEBA loan. This loan accrues no interest until December 31, 2022 and if you pay off the loan before that date, you can receive up to 33 percent forgiveness of the original loan. If you might need this loan, look into it early!
