***Evacuation Rescind for New Remo and Parts of Old Remo***

**Flood Update**

The Kalum and Skeena River levels have receded, due to this, Evacuation Orders have been rescinded for New Remo and parts of Old Remo (see Evacuation Rescinds and maps attached). The RDKS is maintaining a **Declaration of Local State of Emergency Order for Area 'C'; an Evacuation Order for Usk until water levels are safe for the Usk Ferry and Cable/Arial car to resume operations; and an Evacuation Order remains for parts of Old Remo** (see revised map attached).

The Evacuation Alert from June 2<sup>nd</sup> remains for Dutch Valley. New Remo and parts of Old Remo are now on Evacuation Alert only. The RDKS continues to monitor all areas.

**If your area's Evacuation Order is rescinded:**


Please return home as soon as possible to secure your property. Security will not be available in alert areas overnight.

June 8, 2022 at 14:00 hrs

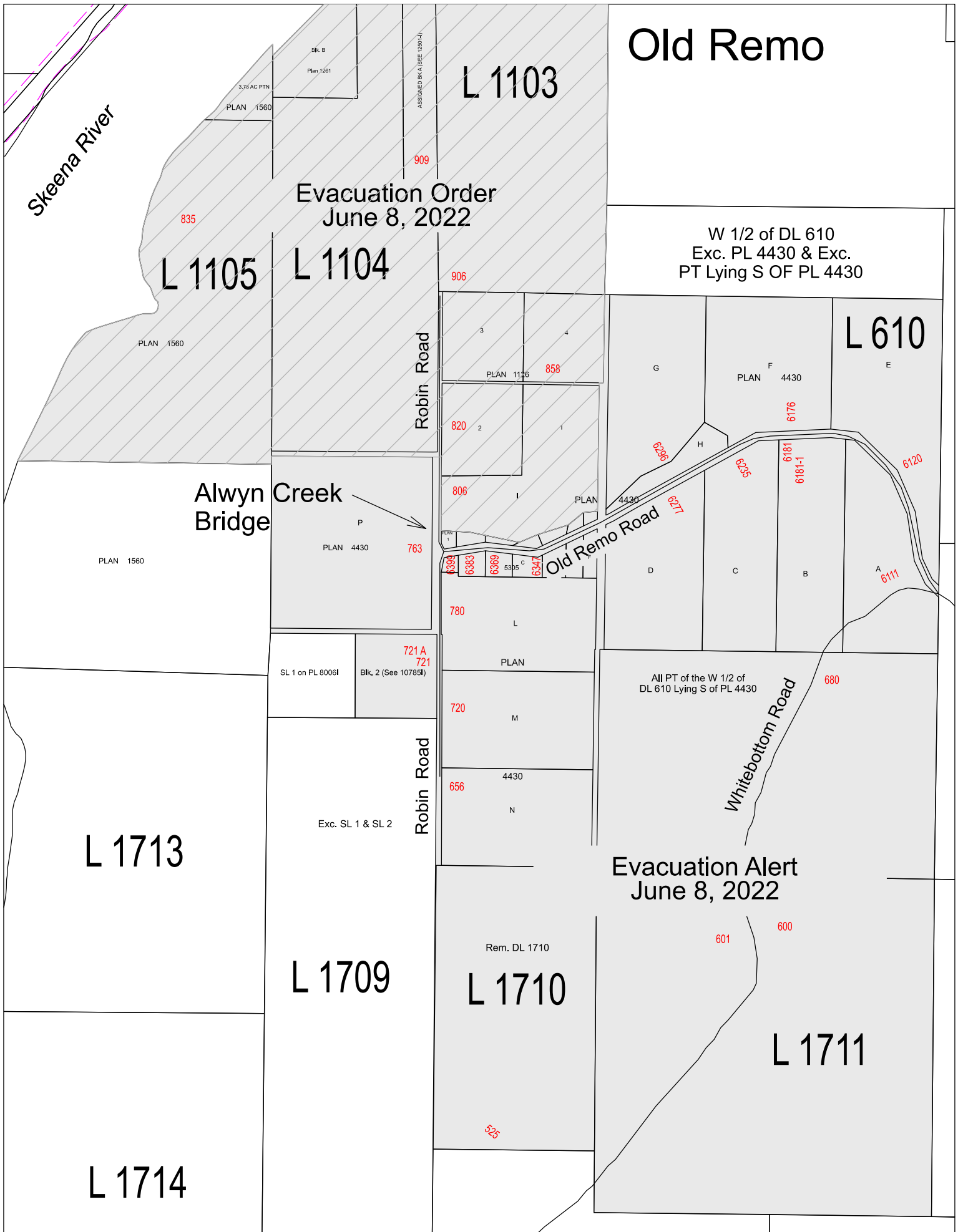

Evacuation Order Boundary: Old Remo  
June 8, 2022
