June is freshet season for the Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine (RDKS). In preparation for possible high water events and potential flooding the RDKS wants to ensure residents have information to prepare their homes, properties and families if flooding occurs.

Sandbags are available at the Thornhill Fire Department (3128 Hwy 16 East, Thornhill) on a self serve basis 8:30am-4:30pm. This location may change to address areas of need as the high water event develops.
