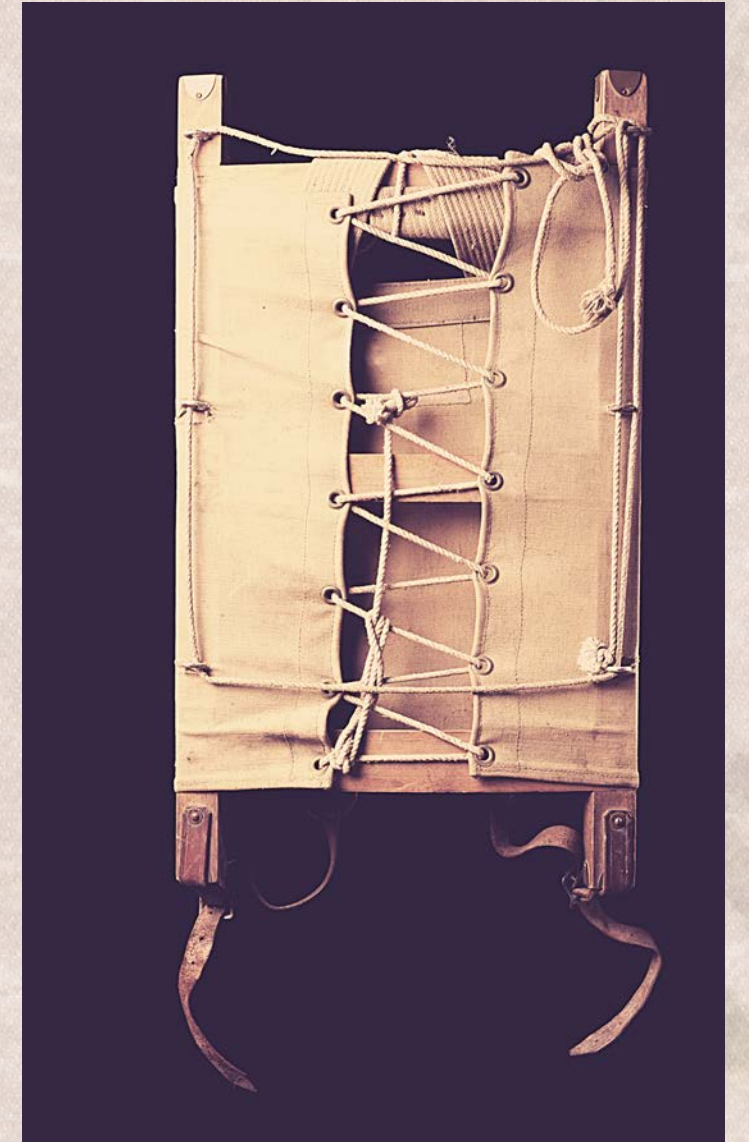

TWO-IN-ONE: A MUSEUM AND A PARK

Heritage Park Museum operates as a regional museum and a park. As a museum, we collect, preserve, display and educate on regional artifacts. We are a major regional historical attraction for local, national and international visitors. We give tours of our museum to visitors and schools all over the region. This fall, we will re-introduce our classroom visits to schools in Terrace and Thornhill, educating kids on the history of their area. We hold many free or by donation events, allowing low-income families to enjoy festivities at the park. We also host a free, educational kids camp each summer, open to all children within the region. Our summer camp kids come from Terrace, Thornhill, Lakeelse, Usk, and Remo. We also rent out our beautiful space for weddings and private events. Our park is ever-changing to display different themes of local history for our communities. We work hard to make our space accessible to any and all in the region.

HERITAGE PARK MUSEUM AT YOUR SERVICE

Heritage Park Museum works with a modest budget, less than that of the Kitimat and Smithers museums. We require core budgeting to do what we do. The recent loss of regional district funding is a 25% reduction in our budget which will seriously impact us. We want to be considered as a service, as the library and sportsplex are. As a service, we offer free education, protection of local history and artifacts, free events, public school programs and more for the region.

WHO ARE WE

Although HPM is owned by the City of Terrace, we, as operators, think and act as a regional museum. We are a volunteer board operating a registered charity, Terrace **and District** Museum Society, who contracts to the City of Terrace to operate Heritage Park Museum. Our board members live in all areas of the region.
